

Hospice of Acadiana Foundation ensures patients' and families' basic needs are being met, while also striving to maximize quality of life. Your donations to the Foundation have a meaningful and significant impact:

- Provided an **electric blanket, hand warmers, socks, sweatshirts, and a hat** for a patient during deep-freeze temperatures
- Installed a new **hot water heater** for a 71-year-old patient
- Delivered a **birthday cake & card** for a 72-year-old patient
- Arranged **dinner & a movie** for a 35-year-old patient's husband and their 2 daughters, so they could enjoy a night out while mom rested at the Calcutta House
- Supplied a **video monitor** for a 70-year-old patient so her husband could see and hear her from another room
- Provided **cleaning supplies** for the home of a 78-year-old patient to meet his basic needs
- Delivered a **radio** to a 62-year-old patient with altered mental status who was in a band and loved music to help him relax
- Purchased a **birthday cake** for a new veteran patient's 75th birthday, to be presented during the Hospice of Acadiana Pinning Ceremony
- Provided **resource materials** for a 63-year-old patient requesting books on dying, liver cell carcinoma, and inspirational topics
- Organized **transportation** for a 94-year-old patient whose house had been struck by lightning and suffered an electrical fire
- Covered a **pet deposit** for a 63-year-old patient to keep her beloved dog & surprised her with a complete pet care package
- Gifted a **Mario Brothers pillowcase** for a 44-year-old patient's 4-year-old grandson, who was coming to visit her
- Provided an **infant blood pressure cuff** for a 4-month-old pediatric patient
- Supplied an **oxygen rolling cart** for an 85-year-old patient to make it easier for her to attend church with her portable oxygen tank
- Provided a **lift chair** for an 82-year-old patient to help him remain mobile as long as possible
- Organized an **in-home photo shoot** for an infant patient and their family so they could have a beautiful keepsake
